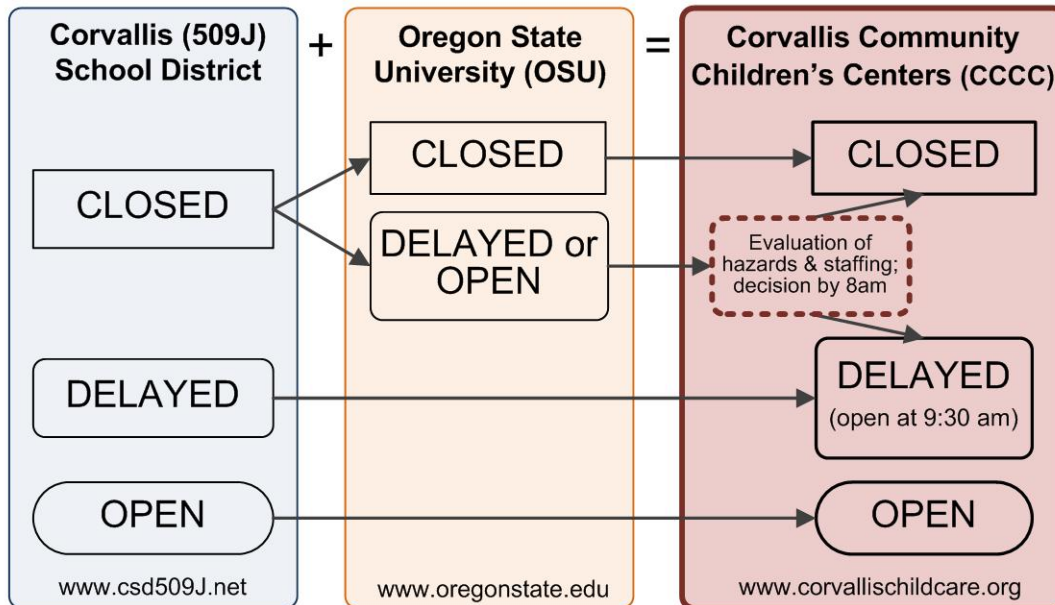


Inclement Weather Decision Tree



Call (541) 752-1274 to listen to recorded updates regarding inclement weather closure or delayed opening beginning at 6:30am. CCCC will also provide notification on the CCCC website, on google calendar, and via google-groups email. Information regarding 509J, OSU and other local closures and are announced widely on radio and television stations, and through Flashalert.net.

Policy:

In the case of inclement weather, the Executive and Site Directors will determine if conditions warrant a closure or delayed opening of our centers. The decision will be based on the severity of the weather, safety concerns, staffing issues, and take into account the decisions of other local organizations (Corvallis School Districts and Oregon State University).

Procedure:

If Oregon State University announces a closure of the Corvallis campus due to hazardous weather conditions, CCCC will also be closed. If the Corvallis 509J School District announces a delayed opening due to weather conditions, CCCC will be on a delayed opening. A delayed opening means that CCCC will open at 9:30am and breakfast will not be served. If 509J is closed or not in session, and weather conditions are hazardous or OSU has announced a delayed opening, there will be a delayed opening, with the possibility of center closure. The Executive Director, in conjunction with the Site Directors, will assess the weather conditions and forecast, road and site conditions, and the availability of staff before making a final decision by 8am.

If weather conditions warrant early closure, as determined by the Executive or Site Director, staff will notify parents to pick up their children.

Notification:

CCCC will post information regarding center closure or delay on the front door of each center, and record a voicemail message for parents calling in. Notification will also be given via google-groups email and the CCCC online calendar (available at corvallischildcare.org). Staff will be notified by their site directors.
